TRAVEL TO KING EDWARD VI HIGH SCHOOL FOR GIRLS 2017

KEHS has a long tradition of attracting pupils from a very wide geographical area and it is very fortunate in the range of public transport, train and bus, that makes the school accessible. So, girls are able to come easily from Lichfield and Wolverhampton, from Walsall and Bromsgrove, from Solihull and Sutton.

The school is situated near many bus routes (the 61, 62, 63 and 144 buses stop within 200 yards of the school) and it is within easy walking distance of the University railway station. The School has dedicated Travel West Midlands buses 885 and 886 (shared with King Edward's School) from [Solihull](#) and [Walsall](#).

It may be useful to have a trial run on public transport before the start of term. It is also useful for your daughter to know of alternative ways home in case she stays for an after-school activity, misses a school bus or one of the services is disrupted.

(There is now a 76 bus which goes from the Bristol Road direct to Solihull).

TRAVEL CARDS

If you only intend to use buses operated by Travel West Midlands, West Midlands Travel Cards are available for young people between the ages of 5-15 (inclusive) and 16-18 year olds eligible for a 16-18 Photocard. (For other travel cards contact Network West Midlands for information about the Network Card – formally Centro Card – www.networkwestmidlands.com or 0121 214 7878).

Young Persons Travel Cards can be used for getting to school or college, all day every day including evenings and holidays. They are valid on all Travel West Midlands buses, from the start to end of normal service, 7 days a week. Travel Cards can be purchased for one week, four weeks or for the whole school term (Term Plus).

From Solihull Station, Streetsbrook Road, Link Road, Warwick Road, Acocks Green, Westley Road, Summer Road, Shaftmoor Lane, Stratford Road and then following the No. 1 bus route to the Bristol Road and Edgbaston Park Road.
